> approx. 35 years old, and the soil is of calcareous-clay. Yields are approx.4-5 tons per hectare. Born from the noble Nebbiolo varietal cultivated in Barolo, this wine benefits from the generous, calcareous-clay soil with a good quantity of sand that is found on the prestigious Cannubi hill. An old vine wine, Barolo Liste is crafted from 35-year-old vines

with desirable east exposure.

Vinification/ Rotary fermenter for 8 days fermentation at a controlled temperature. Aged in 50% new Maturation tonneaux, 50% barriques, 2nd/3rd ageing for 24 months.

**Tasting Notes** The wine has a striking garnet, ruby red color with subtle orange reflections. It has an

ample nose with evident notes of cherry and plum that evolve into hints of tobacco, licorice and cocoa. On the palate, it has a harmonic flavor that is pleasantly dry, with soft

tannins and full body.

"The 2008 Barolo Liste shows the more muscular, sinewy side of Barolo from the town of Barolo. The 2008 is a big, imposing wine, but I am not sure it has enough fruit to stand up to the considerable French oak. Dark cherries, plums, licorice and new leather flow through to the authoritative, virile finish. If the Liste fleshes out it will merit a higher score, but today the wine is very compact. Anticipated maturity: 2016-2026.

These 2008s from Damilano required considerable aeration to show the full breadth of their potential. At times, the wines still seem excessively oaked."

"The 2007 Barolo Liste is another imposing wine from Damilano. Here the tannins and overall structure are much more in evidence, in keeping with a vineyard that tends to yield powerful Baroli. Intense dark fruit, leather, licorice and spices are some of the notes that emerge from this super-ripe, opulent Barolo. This isn't the most elegant wine in the lineup, but there appears to be more than enough fruit to keep up with the tannins. Anticipated maturity: 2015-2025. Damilano's 2007s Baroli are big, massive wines that appear to need several

years in bottle. They have plenty of underlying structure, and while ripe, they are also well balanced."
